HW Burkay® Series 300 Efficiency Upgrade

Please be advised that the HW Burkay Models HW-300 thru HW-670 have undergone an efficiency upgrade in order to meet the new minimum efficiency standards set forth by the Department of Energy's new Energy Efficiency Pact (EPACT). This new efficiency standard goes into effect March 1st 2012. Units manufactured after this date must meet the new standard. Units manufactured prior to March 1st are saleable and can continue to be sold and installed as normal even after the March 1st date.

We will begin production of the 300 series models on Monday, February 20th. Please note that all changes to the unit are internal and affect only the heat exchanger. There are no changes to the water, gas, vent and electrical connections. The new 300 series models are direct replacements for our prior models. I have attached the new series 300 updated manual for your review. No dimensional or connection modifications have been made so the current spec sheets are correct and should be used.

The new series numbers are as follows:

- Series 300 – Standard natural gas units
- Series 301 – Standard propane units
- Series 302 – Standard CSD-1 models natural

One change to note refers to the CSD-1 models, series 302, which will use a new United Technologies control in conjunction with a manual reset switch. The reset switch will require the user to push a manual reset button in the event of control lockout. Unlike prior CSD-1 models the unit will no longer reset by cycling the power and the button must be pushed to reset the unit.
